# CONSTITUTION AND BYLAWS London Magicians Guild

## **ARTICLE I - Name**

- \* Section 1 This organization shall be known as the London Magicians Guild.
- \* Section 2 The London Magicians Guild is affiliated with the International Brotherhood of Magicians, and is recognized by the IBM as Ring #265.

## **ARTICLE II - Purpose**

- \* Section 1 To gather together individuals interested in the study, practice and promotion of the art of magic and its advancement.
- \* Section 2 To encourage and assist every effort which may tend to foster, elevate and advance the art of magic.
- \* Section 3 To facilitate the exchange of ideas and promote harmony and cooperation between those interested in or practicing the art of magic.
- \* Section 4 To abide by the Constitution and bylaws of the International Brotherhood of Magicians and amendments thereto.
- \* Section 5 To advance the ethics of the magical profession, as well as those interested therein, insofar as their relationship to the magical fraternity is concerned.
- \* Section 6 To oppose exposures of the principles of the art of magic to the general public.
- \* Section 7 To expand the membership of the London Magicians Guild. To encourage the populace to take up magic as a hobby or intellectual study.
- \* Section 8 To increase and enhance the entertainment of adults and/or children in the community by exposing them to the performance of magic and thus enhance the imagination of children and recognition of adults.
- \* Section 9 To improve the overall well being of the community by support of worthwhile activities of the community.

## **ARTICLE III – Membership and Dues**

- \* Section 1 The classifications of membership are:
  - Regular Member (12 years of age or older);
  - Honorary Member.

- \* Section 2 Applicants for any class of Membership (except Honorary) must pay appropriate membership dues and fees as determined by the Executive.
- \* Section 3 Honorary Memberships are conferred by a unanimous vote of the membership at any Regular Meeting following:
  - a unanimous recommendation by the full Executive; and
  - the publication in the Ring Newsletter of the meeting date and action that is to take place on the perspective Honorary Member's selection.
- \* Section 4 All members in good standing can vote and hold office.
- \* Section 5 Members who allow their dues to lapse may, within a three year period, become members in good standing by paying current dues. After three years in arrears, individuals must reapply for membership.
- \* Section 6 Annual dues for each classification are as stated in the Policy and Program Manual of the London Magicians Guild.
- \* Section 7 A member may be expelled for unbecoming conduct or unethical practice in magic or indiscriminate exposing of magic, in which case a 3/4 majority vote of the membership shall be required for expulsion.

## **ARTICLE IV – Officers**

- \* Section 1 The officers elected to hold office by simple majority vote of the membership are as follows:
  - President
  - Vice-President
  - Secretary
  - Treasurer
  - Sergeant at Arms
- \* Section 2 All officers shall serve one year with the right of re-election at the end of their term.
- \* Section 3 Elections for officers will be held annually.

## **ARTICLE V – Fees or Special Assessments**

\* Section 1 - Fees or special assessments can be assessed at any time upon approval of a simple majority of the membership present at a regular meeting.

## **ARTICLE VI - Duties and Privileges of Members and Code of Ethics**

\* Section 1 - Article VIII, Duties and Privileges of Members and Code of Ethics Section 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, and 6 of the by-laws of the International Brotherhood of Magicians are adopted in their entirety as Article VI of these by-laws.

## **ARTICLE VII - Rules of the order**

\* Section 1 - The rules of the order shall be governed by the Robert's "Revised Rules of Order".

<u>ARTICLE VIII - Amendments</u>
\* Section 1 - Amendments to these by-laws may be made at any regular meeting by a 3/4 majority vote of the membership.

# **ARTICLE IX - Dissolution**

- \* Section 1 The London Magicians Guild as described herein will cease to exist should any of the following criteria be met:
  - The International Brotherhood of Magicians revokes the club's official IBM Ring status.
  - The club fails to hold a regular meeting for six consecutive months.
  - 3/4 majority vote of the membership in favour of club dissolution.
