January's meeting

January's meeting was a lecture by our own Mike Fisher (aka Amazing Corbin, aka Captain Corbin). Mike put on a superb lecture, complete with lecture notes, an "idea book", and items for sale that complicated his presentation.

Mike has been doing magic for most of his life, and has been a full-time magician for 5 years. Mike's lecture was on Magical Creativity – or as he puts it: "An in-depth educational insight into magical and non-magical structured Creativity in the workplace." And creative it was! After viewing a video of samples of his Amazing Corbin and Captain Corbin performances, he showed us many results of problems he has encountered when creating new effects, like:

- How to add an animal into a routine without using a real animal;
- How he turned a mental card effect into a search for buried treasure maps;
- Taking effects like "Two in the hand; one in the pocket" and tailoring them to different occasions by using different items;
- Causing a kid to choose the only can of beans that had a roll of toilet paper inside (guess what effect used a "fart machine"?);
- Adding some major "punch" to a fish production by creatively adding simple, inexpensive, reusable exploding confetti devices that Mike developed.

Mike handed out "idea books" to everyone – a simple way to document the ideas that we all have every day but forget to write down.

The lecture was full of ideas on how to take effects you do today and drastically altering them to create larger presentations with much greater impact. Mike put a lot of effort into this night – and it was certainly well worth it. I'm sure everyone walked away with something they could apply. Well done, Mike!!

Psychic accused of lottery scam

Several members of Peel Region's Hindu community forked over hundreds of thousands of dollars to the alleged "Swami Swindler" Mohammad Roshan Zameer – then he upped and left, leaving nary a coin -- or prayer -- behind.

He was also known as "Brother Roshan" to the community. If anyone had a problem, Brother Roshan would solve it in a few days, free of charge – he told his listeners on his 540 AM radio show. Some had family problems they wanted fixed. For others, it was cancer or financial problems. "I have a lot of power with the god," he would say. Then he would perform magic tricks to impress his potential victims.

For example, a 6/49 lottery ticket was pulled from a boiled egg. Written on the ticket: "You are a lucky person. You will win \$21 million." But only if they forked out \$210,000 – which, of course, they did!
